Clothing

To encourage independence, can you please dress your child in clothes that will enable them to take their clothes on and off by themselves.

With the approach of the cooler weather, it is advisable to dress your child in no more than three layers, e.g a vest, a long sleeved cotton T-shirt and a sweat shirt. Please do not over dress your child as this restricts air flow which prevents the maintenance of warmth.

All clothing should be labeled.

Outside Gate

For safety reasons, please ensure when entering or leaving the kindergarten premises that the gate is closed.

Arrival and Collection of Children

Children should arrive and be collected promptly.

Unless your child travels by bus and weather permitting, you should remain in the playground with your child until classes commence at 9.30 a.m.
